No. A-12/11/14/89 E. 1(A)—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 97 read with sub-section (2) & sub-section (2-A) of that section, section 16 and sub-section (3) of section 17 of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948 as amended by 29 of 1989) and supersession of the E.S.I. Corporation (Medical Commissioner) Recruitment Regulations, 1991 except in respect of things done or committed to be done before such supersession, the Corporation hereby makes the following regulations regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Medical Commissioner as under:—

Short Title and Commencement :

- These regulations may be called the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (Medical Commissioner) (Amendment) Recruitment Regulations, 1994
- They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Gazette of India.

2. Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay :

The number of said post, its classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the schedule annexed to these regulations.

3. Method of Recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc. :

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the said schedule.

4. Disqualification :

No person—

- who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

- who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post provided that the Director General, may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these regulations.

5. Power to Relax :

Where the Director General of the Corporation is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and after obtaining specific prior approval of the Central Government relax any of the provisions of these regulations with respect to any clause or category of persons.

6. Residuary Power :

Subject to the provisions of these regulations, all regulations and condition as laid down in the ESIC (Recruitment) Regulations, 1965 as amended from time to time applicable to Group 'A' posts shall apply to the post specified in the schedule annexed to these regulations.

7. Savings :

Nothing in these regulations shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.
